WHEREAS, the District must continue to consider the greatest good for the greatest number for the longest term (Gifford Pinchot); and


WHEREAS, our community benefits from agencies built on a culture of serving others;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the District ("**Board**") as follows:


1. Commitment. The Board commits to making decisions in accordance with the principles and values expressed in this and similar District Resolutions.

3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its approval by the Board.






