#### 2023 Budget

Chief Wolf went over the 2023 pension budget noting that changes were made to add budget to cover the actuarial that will be required in 2023 and also the retiree benefit payment amount was increased to reflect new members entering pension.

#### Discussion

William Harkins acknowledged that the board approved the change so that a qualifying year of pension is the same as LOSAP in the active membership policy. He asked the board if that change could be retroactive prior to 2022. He had concerns that there were members in 2021 and earlier that missed earning pension by a call or two. Discussion took place. No changes were made at this meeting.

William Harkins had one more request of the board and that was to consider allocating up to 1 mill of revenue to the pension fund.

President Hodde noted that a \$14,000 transfer from the Schwab account would take place in the coming days to balance the books for the year 2022 for making the monthly pension payments.
